Before the refit, the extraction system in place was in need of some maintenance, as well as the whole cook line being a generally dark and dim place. There was definitely room for improvement, which the design team were happy to help with.

We had to consider noise pollution from the extraction as the ductwork could be visable from a small number of the rooms.


The solution to this problem was a high velocity discharge cowl. Noise from the extraction was mainly down to the fans being worked to hard, or the ductwork being too small resulting in the air producing excess noise as it travels through the system.

We increased the diameter of the ductwork to the point where it was large enough to accommodate the amount of air being extracted. It is then fired through the high velocity cowl to discharge it high into the air.



The Design

Setting out to design and kit out this bustling city hotel, Oliver joined up with the owners to refit their busy establishment with state of the art equipment, and modern extraction solutions. Designs for the refit were created using the latest CAD software, they include plans for advanced extraction systems as well as perfect placement for the new list of equipment.

The backing of the spine was clad with clean panels of stainless steel for a clean professional look.




