STRUCTURE

1. Wide slots.
2. Slot selection.
3. ON/OFF indicator light.
4. The temperature control with timing function.
5. Oven body.
6. Crumb tray.
7. Manual uplift bar.

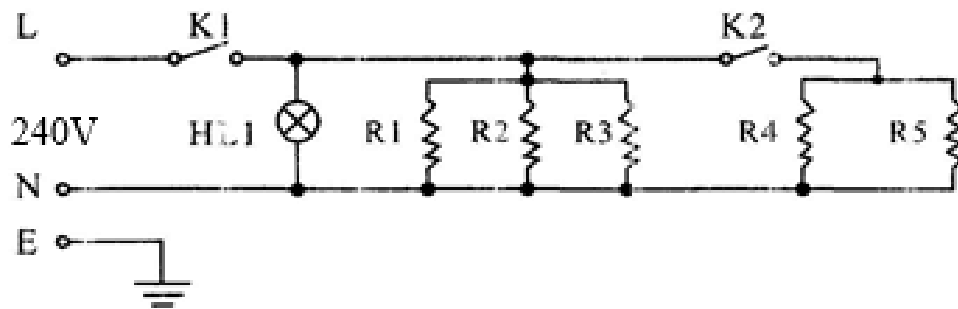
Operation

- Connect the appliance to the mains power.
- Insert desired pieces of bread.
- Select the number of pieces of bread using the slot selection.
- Adjust the timer to desired time. The ON/OFF indicator will now light up.
- Pull the lever up to lower the bread into the toaster.

Maintaining your Toaster

- The power must be turned off when maintaining the machine.
- The exterior of the toaster can be cleaned with soft cloth. **DO NOT USE CORROSIVE CLEANING PRODUCTS ON THIS MACHINE.**
- Dry thoroughly after cleaning before use.
- Empty the crumb tray regularly by sliding out and sliding back in once empty.
- A qualified technician should carry out any repairs on your Cater-Cook toaster.

ELECTRICS



K1 - The on-off timing

K2 - The on-off of alternative

HL1 - The indicator light for power

R1-R5-The electric thermal plate

- This appliance is supplied with a 13Amp BS1363 standard fused plug, that should be connected to a suitable mains socket.
- The appliance is wired with a live wire (brown), a neutral wire (blue) and an earth wire (green/ yellow).
- To prevent from electric shock do not immerse any part of this product in water or other liquid
- Bread may burn therefore toasters must not be used near or below curtains and other combustible materials.
- **When toasting do not leave appliance unattended**
- Do not attempt to dislodge bread when the toaster is plugged in
- Do not allow the cable to touch hot surfaces, or to hang over the edge of a table.
- Do not operate this appliance if the cord or plug is damaged
- Do not use outdoors
- Accessible surfaces of the toaster may get hot during use
