My Cycle

Save your favourite cycle with your favourite drying parameters and get the same results every cycle!

Cotton

4:48

For full cotton loads.

Jeans

2:40

To dry jeans or similar items that have been spun at high speeds.

Bed Linen

2:50

For bed linen and sheets / bulky items.

Shirts

1:00

For easy laundry such as shirts equipped with anti crease functionality to minimise ironing.

Cool / Warm

0:10

Cool - to air items without heating.
To dry individual items or finishing.

Refresh

0:20

To refresh clothes or remove odors.



Standard

2:55

To dry thin synthetics textiles which are not ironed.

Iron

2:20

For cotton that needs to remain damp for ironing.

Mix

1:40

For a mix of cotton and synthetics.

Wool

2:05

For machine washable wool items.



Extra

1:30

For thick or multi layer fabric to be dried completely.

Std Synthetic

1:20

To dry thin synthetic textiles which are not ironed i.e socks.
