

NEW Energy Labels Explained

With energy efficiency becoming increasingly more important, so is the demand for appliances to become more eco friendly.


The new energy label was launched in **November 2020** with the aim of making the labels **easier to understand** with more opportunity for manufactures to build more energy efficient appliances without adding more '+'s.

What is different?

Appliances rated A+++ on the old scale are now rated at around D on the new scale. The efficiency hasn't changed, the labelling has.

The NEW Label...

- 1 The appliances energy efficiency class.
- 2 The new scale is A - G (replacing A+++ - D).
- 3 QR code.
- 4 Weighted energy consumption per 100 cycles.
- 5 Rated capacity on a 'ECO 40-60' programme.
- 6 Duration of the 'ECO 40-60' programme.
- 7 Weighted water consumption per cycle.
- 8 Spin-drying efficiency class.
- 9 Airbourne acoustical noise emissions & class.
